#### **NOTICE OF PETITIONS**

The Nevada Transportation Authority ("Authority") has received Petitions, designated as *Docket Number 08-10021: 2009 CES*, from Las Vegas VIP Limousines, LLC and AWG Charter Services, LLC, fully regulated passenger carriers with authority to provide charter limousine service in the State of Nevada. The Petitioners seek to deviate from the operating authority granted under their respective Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN's) for a specific purpose and for a specific period of time. The Petitions are based on an expected increase in demand related to the International Consumer Electronics Show ("CES") to be held in Las Vegas from January 8, 2009 through January 11, 2009.

The Petitions were filed pursuant to Chapter 706 of the Nevada Revised Statutes ("NRS") and the Nevada Administrative Code ("NAC"). Under NRS 706.151, the Authority has legal jurisdiction and authority over this matter.

The Petitions are on file under *Docket Number 08-10021: 2009 CES* and are available for viewing at the office of the Authority, 2290 South Jones Blvd., Suite 110, Las Vegas, Nevada 89146.

All carriers who wish to seek similar relief from the Authority may do so by filing written Petitions under *Docket Number 08-10021: 2009 CES*. Petitions must be filed at the Authority's office located at 2290 South Jones Blvd., Suite 110, Las Vegas, Nevada 89146 on or before December 12, 2008.

Persons with a direct and substantial interest in this matter may file Petitions for Leave to Intervene at the Authority's office located at 2290 South Jones Blvd., Suite 110, Las Vegas, Nevada 89146. Such Petitions must conform to the Authority's regulations and must be filed on or before December 1, 2008.

Interested persons may submit Protests for filing at the Authority's office. Protests must conform to the Authority's regulations. Other written comments may also be submitted for filing.
