Business & Industry Seeking Taxicab Authority Administrator

Las Vegas – The Department of Business & Industry today announced that it is seeking candidates for the position of Taxicab Authority Administrator.

The Taxicab Authority is a dynamic State agency that oversees the safety and comfort of the riding public in Clark County. In the 2010 annual taxi survey for hotels.com, Las Vegas cab drivers rated ranked in the top three of all ten survey categories. The agency strives to maintain that positive experience for the public by enforcing standards and quality of conduct for cab company owners and cab drivers according to Nevada Revised Statutes and Administrative Code chapter 706. The Taxicab Authority currently regulates 16 taxicab companies in Clark County along with approximately 9,000 cab drivers operating a taxicab fleet of nearly 3,000 vehicles.

The pivotal role of the Administrator involves acting as a liaison between staff and the Taxicab Authority Board. Duties also include budget development, personnel management and responding to legislative initiatives. Based in Las Vegas, the Taxicab Administrator position requires a Bachelor's degree in business administration, or a related field, and a minimum of five years management experience in a related field. An equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered. The position pays up to \$97,901.
