Business & Industry Appoints New Taxicab Authority Administrator

Las Vegas – Nevada Department of Business & Industry Director Terry Johnson today announced the appointment of Charles D. Harvey as Administrator of the Taxicab Authority. The Authority, which oversees approximately 9,000 cab drivers operating a fleet of approximately 3,000 taxicabs in Clark County, regulates taxicab fares in addition to when and where taxis may operate.

Mr. Harvey brings an array of administrative experience to this position, having previously served as an executive level administrator in State and local government over the past several years. He most recently held the position of Stimulus Director for the American Recovery & Reinvestment Act for the Office of the Governor. Mr. Harvey's professional past includes acting as Assistant County Recorder for Clark County – as well as work with the U.S. Geological Survey and service as a member of the United States Air Force.

Mr. Harvey holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Management. He is currently pursuing in Executive M.B.A. from the University of Nevada in Las Vegas. His volunteer service includes United Way, Salvation Army, Habitat for Humanity, National MS Society, Goodie Two Shoes, and Project Homeless Connect.

“Mr. Harvey has the experience, professionalism and dedication needed to oversee this dynamic agency. His leadership will ensure that the Taxicab Authority efficiently and effectively serves the riding public, so that every passenger’s cab experience is a positive one,” said Director Johnson.
