Real Estate Division's Investigation Results in Voluntary Surrender of License

Las Vegas – After a comprehensive investigation, the Real Estate Division summarily suspended the license of Las Vegas-based corporate broker and property manager Sharon A. Wilson (B.0030625, PM.0130625 and PM.0143730).

Ms. Wilson was licensed as a Corporate Broker for Fortune Holding Group, Inc. dba Fortune Properties and an Individual Broker under the name of Sharon Wilson. She held a property management permit for each broker license.

Based on the Real Estate Division's investigation, at the Real Estate Commission meeting in September, Ms. Wilson voluntarily surrendered her license. As a result, no further administrative action will be taken against her. However, she is prohibited from acting as a real estate broker or property manager.

"The Division remains committed to ensuring that licensees are operating according to the law and are disciplined appropriately if they are not," said Real Estate Division Administrator Gail Anderson.
