Because of Governor Sisolak's March closure of nonessential businesses in Nevada, Nevada OSHA suspended scheduled payments to the agency in a letter dated March 18, 2020. This suspension of scheduled payments has been reviewed by the agency and the following measures will be taken for businesses that are making scheduled payments for debt owed to Nevada OSHA.

As of Tuesday, May 26, 2020, the delay of scheduled payments for debt owed to Nevada OSHA will continue through June 30, 2020. This extension of the postponement of scheduled payments for debt owed to Nevada OSHA will be re-evaluated during the week starting June 23, 2020.
